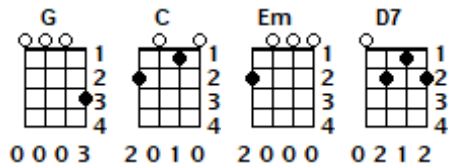


Blowin' In The Wind
