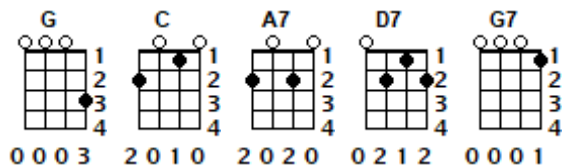


Roly Poly
